5	SECTION 1. Section 30.05(b), Penal Code, is amended by
6	adding Subdivision (8) to read as follows:
7	(8) "Residential land" means real property improved by
8	a dwelling and zoned for or otherwise authorized for single-family
9	or multifamily use.
10	SECTION 2. Section 30.05, Penal Code, is amended by
11	amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsection (k) to read
12	as follows:
13	(c) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that
14	the actor at the time of the offense was <u>:</u>
15	(1) a fire fighter or emergency medical services
16	personnel, as [that term is] defined by Section 773.003, Health and
17	Safety Code, acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty
18	under exigent circumstances <u>;</u>
19	(2) an employee or agent of an electric utility, as
20	defined by Section 31.002, Utilities Code, or an employee or agent
21	of a gas utility, as defined by Section 101.003 or 121.001,
22	Utilities Code, who was performing a duty within the scope of
23	employment or agency; or

No. 2609 1 (A) employed by or acting as agent for an entity that had, or that the person reasonably believed had, effective 2 3 consent or authorization provided by law to enter the property; and 4 (B) performing a duty within the scope of that 5 employment or agency. 6 (d) An offense under Subsection (e) is a Class C misdemeanor 7 unless it is committed in a habitation or unless the actor carries a 8 deadly weapon on or about the actor's person during the commission of the offense, in which event it is a Class A misdemeanor. 9 An offense under Subsection (k) is a Class C misdemeanor unless it is 10 committed in a building or habitation or unless the actor carries a 11 12 deadly weapon on or about the actor's person during the commission of the offense, in which event it is a Class A misdemeanor. 13 An 14 offense under Subsection (a) is a Class C [B] misdemeanor, except 15 that the offense is: (1) a Class B misdemeanor if it is shown on the trial 16 17 of the offense that the defendant has been previously convicted of an offense under this section; and 18 (2) a Class A misdemeanor if: 19 (A) [(1)] the offense is committed: 20 21 (i) $[(\Lambda)]$ in a habitation or a shelter 22 center; 23 (ii) [(B)] on a Superfund site; or 24 (iii) [(C)] in critical on or а infrastructure facility; or 25 26 (B) [(2)] the actor carries a deadly weapon on or 27 about his person during the commission of the offense.

No. 2609 (k) A person commits an offense if without express consent 1 or if without authorization provided by any law, whether in writing 2 3 or other form, the person: 4 (1) enters or remains on residential land of another; 5 and 6 (2) had notice that the entry was forbidden or 7 received notice to depart but failed to do so. 8 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 9 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 10 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 11 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 12 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 13 14 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 15 date. 16 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
