4	SECTION 1. Subsection 418.108(i), Government Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:

7	restriction that exceeds a restriction authorized by Section
8	352.051, Local Government Code. [A restriction that exceeds a
9	restriction authorized by Section 352.051, Local Government Code,
10	is effective only:
11	[(1) for 60 hours unless extended by the governor; and
12	[ <del>(2) if the county judge requests the governor to</del>
13	grant an extension of the restrictions.
14	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
15	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
16	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
17	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
18	Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
