A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the provision of home health services under the Medicaid program in accordance with authorization by a licensed 3 nurse practitioner or a physician assistant. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 32.067, Human Resources Code, is amended 6 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 7 (c) The department shall assure that a licensed nurse 8 9 practitioner or a physician assistant is permitted to authorize the provision of home health services to individuals enrolled in the 10 11 Texas Health Steps Comprehensive Care Program, to the extent that a 12 nurse practitioner or physician assistant is permitted to authorize those services under Chapter 142, Health and Safety Code. 13 14 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 15 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 16 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 17 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 18 waiver or authorization is granted. 19 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
