## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to enhanced penalties for assault of a health care
- 3 services provider or a mental health services provider.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.01(b), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (b) An offense under Subsection (a)(1) is a Class A
- 8 misdemeanor, except that the offense is a felony of the third degree
- 9 if the offense is committed against:
- 10 (1) a person the actor knows is a public servant while
- 11 the public servant is lawfully discharging an official duty, or in
- 12 retaliation or on account of an exercise of official power or
- 13 performance of an official duty as a public servant;
- 14 (2) a person whose relationship to or association with
- 15 the defendant is described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or
- 16 71.005, Family Code, if it is shown on the trial of the offense that
- 17 the defendant has been previously convicted of an offense under
- 18 this chapter, Chapter 19, or Section 20.03, 20.04, or 21.11 against
- 19 a person whose relationship to or association with the defendant is
- 20 described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 71.005, Family Code;
- 21 (3) a person who contracts with government to perform
- 22 a service in a facility as defined by Section 1.07(a)(14), Penal
- 23 Code, or Section 51.02(13) or (14), Family Code, or an employee of
- 24 that person:

- 1 (A) while the person or employee is engaged in
- 2 performing a service within the scope of the contract, if the actor
- 3 knows the person or employee is authorized by government to provide
- 4 the service; or
- 5 (B) in retaliation for or on account of the
- 6 person's or employee's performance of a service within the scope of
- 7 the contract;
- 8 (4) a person the actor knows is a security officer
- 9 while the officer is performing a duty as a security officer; [or]
- 10 (5) a person the actor knows is emergency services
- 11 personnel while the person is providing emergency services:
- 12 (6) a person the actor knows is a health care services
- 13 provider while the person is providing health care services; or
- 14 (7) a person the actor knows is a mental health
- 15 <u>services provider while the person is providing mental health</u>
- 16 <u>services</u>.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 22.01, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 18 Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:
- 19 <u>(d-1)</u> For purposes of Subsection (b), the actor is presumed
- 20 to have known the person assaulted was a health care services
- 21 provider or a mental health services provider if the person was
- 22 wearing a conspicuous badge or name tag or distinctive clothing
- 23 that would identify the person as a health care services provider or
- 24 <u>a mental health services provider.</u>
- 25 SECTION 3. Section 22.01(e), Penal Code, is amended by
- 26 adding Subdivision (2) to read as follows:
- 27 (2) "Health care services provider" and "mental health

- 1 <u>services provider" have the meanings assigned by Section 22.011.</u>
- 2 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 3 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 5 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 6 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 7 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 8 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
- 9 date.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
