- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 54.016 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 54.016. LIMITATION ON TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES. (a)
- 9 In this section, "tuition" includes:
- 10 (1) tuition for which the rates are prescribed by this
- 11 chapter; and
- 12 (2) tuition charged by an institution of higher
- 13 <u>education under Section 54.0513 or another law authorizing an</u>
- 14 institution to establish tuition rates.
- 15 (b) Notwithstanding Section 54.0513 and any other provision
- 16 of this chapter, the governing board of an institution of higher
- 17 education may not charge during any academic year a total amount of
- 18 tuition and mandatory fees per semester credit hour that, when
- 19 combined with the amount of undedicated general revenue funds
- 20 appropriated to the institution for instruction and operations for
- 21 that year for each semester credit hour for which a student pays
- 22 tuition and mandatory fees in that year, exceeds by more than six
- 23 percent the sum of the total amount of tuition and mandatory fees
- 24 charged under this chapter by the institution per semester credit

- 1 hour during the preceding academic year and the amount of
- 2 <u>undedicated general revenue funds appropriated to the ins</u>titution
- 3 for instruction and operations for that preceding year for each
- 4 semester credit hour for which a student pays tuition and mandatory
- 5 fees in that year.
- 6 (c) A semester credit hour taken by a nonresident student is
- 7 <u>not included in the computation under Subsection (b).</u>
- 8 <u>(d) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may</u>
- 9 permit an institution of higher education to increase tuition or
- 10 mandatory fees in excess of the limited amount prescribed with
- 11 respect to each semester credit hour for the tuition and fees by
- 12 Subsection (b) if, in the academic year for which the increase is
- 13 proposed, the institution adds an educational program that the
- 14 coordinating board determines will support one or more goals of
- 15 "Closing the Gaps," the state's master plan for higher education.
- 16 The coordinating board shall determine the amount of an increase
- 17 that may be permitted under this subsection as the coordinating
- 18 board considers reasonable to fund the educational program.
- 19 (e) The coordinating board may adopt rules as necessary to
- 20 administer this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 54.016, Education Code, as added by this
- 22 Act, does not affect tuition and mandatory fees charged under
- 23 Chapter 54, Education Code, for a semester or term before the
- 24 2011-2012 academic year.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
