- 3 with speed limits or a traffic-control signal on a highway or street

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 542.2035, Transportation Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 542.2035. AUTOMATED TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEMS
- 9 PROHIBITED [LIMITATION ON MUNICIPALITIES]. (a) A local authority
- 10 [municipality] may not implement or operate an automated traffic
- 11 control system with respect to a highway or street under its
- 12 jurisdiction [for the purpose of enforcing compliance with posted
- 13 speed limits]. The attorney general shall enforce this subsection.
- 14 (b) In this section, "automated traffic control system"
- 15 means <u>a system consisting of</u> a photographic device, radar device,
- 16 laser device, or other electrical or mechanical device that
- 17 [designed to]:

- 18 (1) <u>is capable of producing one or more recorded</u>
- 19 photographic or digital images depicting the license plate attached
- 20 to the front or rear of a motor vehicle that is not operated in
- 21 compliance with a posted speed limit or the instructions of a
- 22 traffic-control signal; and
- (2) is used by the local authority to enforce
- 24 compliance with a posted speed limit or the instructions of a

- 1 traffic-control signal by imposition of a civil or administrative
- 2 penalty against the owner or operator of the motor vehicle [record
- 3 the speed of a motor vehicle; and
- 4 [(2) obtain one or more photographs or other recorded
- 5 images of:

- 7 [(B) the license plate attached to the vehicle;
- 8 or
- 9 [(C) the operator of the vehicle).
- SECTION 2. Section 27.031(a), Government Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (a) In addition to the jurisdiction and powers provided by
- 13 the constitution and other law, the justice court has original
- 14 jurisdiction of:
- 15 (1) civil matters in which exclusive jurisdiction is
- 16 not in the district or county court and in which the amount in
- 17 controversy is not more than \$10,000, exclusive of interest;
- 18 (2) cases of forcible entry and detainer; and
- 19 (3) foreclosure of mortgages and enforcement of liens
- 20 on personal property in cases in which the amount in controversy is
- 21 otherwise within the justice court's jurisdiction[; and
- [(4) cases arising under Chapter 707, Transportation
- 23 Code, outside a municipality's territorial limits].
- SECTION 3. Section 133.004, Local Government Code, as
- 25 amended by Chapters 718 (H.B. 2359), 1027 (H.B. 1623), and 1149
- 26 (S.B. 1119), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007,
- 27 is reenacted and amended to read as follows:

- 23 (10) the filing fee for the judicial fund imposed in

- 26 [(11) the portion of the civil or administrative
- 27 penalty described by Section 542.406(c)(1), Transportation Code,

- 1 imposed by a local authority to enforce compliance with the
- 2 instructions of a traffic-control signal;
- 3 [(11) the portion of the civil or administrative
- 4 penalty described by Section 707.008(a)(1), Transportation Code,
- 5 imposed by a local authority to enforce compliance with the
- 6 instructions of a traffic-control signal].
- 7 SECTION 4. The following are repealed:
- 8 (1) Section 29.003(g), Government Code;
- 9 (2) Chapter 782, Health and Safety Code;
- 10 (3) Sections 542.405 and 542.406, Transportation
- 11 Code; and
- 12 (4) Chapter 707, Transportation Code.
- SECTION 5. (a) The repeal by this Act of Chapter 707,
- 14 Transportation Code, does not affect the validity of a proceeding
- 15 initiated or a civil penalty imposed under that chapter before the
- 16 effective date of this Act. A proceeding initiated or a civil
- 17 penalty imposed under Chapter 707 of that code before the effective
- 18 date of this Act is governed by the applicable law in effect before
- 19 the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose.
- (b) Notwithstanding the repeal by this Act of Chapter 707,
- 22 Transportation Code, if before June 1, 2009, a local authority had
- 23 enacted an ordinance under former Section 707.002 of that chapter
- 24 to implement a photographic traffic signal enforcement system and
- 25 entered into a contract for the administration and enforcement of
- 26 the system, the local authority may continue to operate the system
- 27 under that ordinance and under the terms of that contract until the

- 1 expiration date specified in the contract as the contract existed
- 2 on June 1, 2009.
- 3 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
