A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to taking into account the cost of fuel in establishing the
- 3 transportation allotment for school districts and counties
- 4 operating public school transportation systems.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 42.155, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (c) Each district or county operating a regular
- 10 transportation system is entitled to an allotment based on the
- 11 daily cost per regular eligible student of operating and
- 12 maintaining the regular transportation system and the linear
- 13 density of that system. In determining the cost, [the commissioner
- 14 shall give consideration to [factors affecting the actual cost of
- 15 providing these transportation services in each district or county
- 16 shall be taken into account including, as determined under
- 17 Subsection (c-1), any increase in the price of gasoline, diesel, or
- 18 other fuel needed for the transportation system. The average
- 19 actual cost is to be computed by the commissioner [and included for
- 20 consideration by the legislature in the General Appropriations
- 21 Act]. The allotment per mile of approved route may not exceed the
- 22 amount set by appropriation.
- 23 <u>(c-1)</u> For purposes of Subsection (c), in establishing the
- 24 allotment per mile of approved route, the cost of gasoline, diesel,

- 1 and other fuels shall be biennially adjusted for any increases in
- 2 the cost of those fuels as reflected in the Texas consumer price
- 3 index, as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United
- 4 States Department of Labor, as follows, whichever is greater:
- 5 <u>(1) the monthly average percentage increase in the</u>
- 6 cost of fuel during the 12-month period ending on December 31 of
- 7 each even-numbered year; or
- 8 (2) the highest three-month rolling average
- 9 percentage increase during the 12-month period ending on December
- 10 31 of each even-numbered year.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
