A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the regulation and practice of engineering.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1001.056, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 6 (c) The exemption provided by this section does not apply to
- 7 <u>a person or entity that is:</u>
- 8 (1) providing services necessary to comply with
- 9 windstorm certification standards for a residential dwelling; or
- 10 (2) constructing, enlarging, altering, or repairing,
- 11 or drawing plans or specifications for, a residential dwelling slab
- 12 located on soil with a plasticity index of greater than 30,
- 13 <u>determined in accordance with ASTM International standard D4318-05</u>
- 14 (Standard Test Methods for Liquid Limit, Plastic Limit, and
- 15 Plasticity Index of Soils) as that standard was in effect on January
- 16 1, 2009.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 1001, Occupations Code, is
- 18 amended by adding Section 1001.067 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 1001.067. CERTAIN FIRE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES. This
- 20 chapter does not prohibit the professional use of the term "fire
- 21 engineer" by a member of a fire department in a municipality with a
- 22 population of one million or more that has adopted Chapter 143,
- 23 Local Government Code, and to which Subchapter G of that chapter
- 24 does not generally apply, who:

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- 1 (1) holds the position of fire apparatus operator; and
- 2 (2) is not otherwise engaged in the practice of
- 3 <u>engineering</u>.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
