A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to governmental liability for interest resulting from a
- 3 claim for payment for goods or services.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2251.002(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Subchapter D, Subchapter B does
- 8 not apply to a payment made by a governmental entity, vendor, or
- 9 subcontractor if:
- 10 (1) there is a bona fide dispute between the
- 11 governmental entity [political subdivision] and a vendor,
- 12 contractor, subcontractor, or supplier about the goods delivered or
- 13 the service performed that causes the payment to be late;
- 14 (2) there is a bona fide dispute between a vendor and a
- 15 subcontractor or between a subcontractor and its supplier about the
- 16 goods delivered or the service performed that causes the payment to
- 17 be late;
- 18 (3) the terms of a federal contract, grant,
- 19 regulation, or statute prevent the governmental entity from making
- 20 a timely payment with federal funds; or
- 21 (4) the invoice is not mailed to the person to whom it
- 22 is addressed in strict accordance with any instruction on the
- 23 purchase order relating to the payment.
- SECTION 2. Section 2251.042, Government Code, is amended by

- 1 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 2 (d) A governmental entity is not liable for interest under
- 3 this section if the governmental entity's invoice payment is late
- 4 because of a bona fide dispute between the governmental entity and a
- 5 vendor, contractor, subcontractor, or supplier concerning the
- 6 goods delivered or the service performed.
- 7 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 8 a contract entered into or renewed on or after the effective date of
- 9 this Act. A contract entered into or renewed before the effective
- 10 date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed on the date the
- 11 contract was entered into or renewed, and that law is continued in
- 12 effect for that purpose.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
