- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 343, Health and Safety 5
- Code, is amended by adding Section 343.0112 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 343.0112. BARKING DOGS IN CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL AREAS. 7
- (a) This section applies only to the unincorporated area of a 8
- 9 county with a population of 275,000 or more.
- (b) It is a public nuisance under Section 343.011 to allow 10
- the barking of or another noise made by a dog outdoors on premises 11
- 12 in a neighborhood if a reasonable person would find the noise
- 13 objectionable.

- 14 (c) In determining whether a noise is objectionable to a
- reasonable person under this section, the following factors may be 15
- 16 considered:
- (1) the time of day the noise is produced; 17
- 18 (2) the proximity of the production of the noise to
- other premises; and 19
- 20 (3) whether the sound is recurrent, intermittent, or
- 21 constant.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24
