## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the sale of used, surplus, or salvage property and

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 775, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter I to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER I. SURPLUS AND SALVAGE PROPERTY
8	Sec. 775.251. SALE OF SURPLUS OR SALVAGE PROPERTY. (a) In
9	this section:
10	(1) "Salvage property" means personal property, other
11	than wastepaper, that because of use, time, or accident is so
12	damaged, used, or consumed that it has no value for the purpose for
13	which it was originally intended.
14	(2) "Surplus property" means personal property that is
15	in excess of the needs of its owner, that is not required for the
16	owner's foreseeable needs, and that possesses some usefulness for
17	the purpose for which it was intended or for some other purpose.
18	(3) "Volunteer fire department" means an association
19	<pre>that:</pre>
20	(A) operates firefighting equipment;
21	(B) is organized primarily to provide and
22	actively provides firefighting services;
23	(C) does not pay its members compensation other
24	than nominal compensation; and

- 1 (D) does not distribute any of its income to its
- 2 members, officers, or governing body, other than for reimbursement
- 3 <u>of expenses.</u>
- 4 (b) Notwithstanding other law, a district may sell used
- 5 firefighting equipment, including equipment described by Sections
- 6 419.040 and 419.041, Government Code, to a volunteer fire
- 7 department in any district or to another district for fair market
- 8 value if the equipment met the National Fire Protection Association
- 9 Standards at the original time of purchase.
- 10 (c) A district may contract to supply surplus or salvage
- 11 property to any volunteer fire department or district in this state
- 12 <u>at fair market value.</u>
- 13 (d) The district may determine the fair market value of used
- 14 equipment, surplus property, and salvage property sold under
- 15 Subsections (b) and (c).
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
