- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 25.0811, Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- Sec. 25.0811. FIRST DAY OF INSTRUCTION. $[\frac{a}{a}]$ The board of
- 7 trustees of a [A] school district shall determine the first day of
- 8 [may not begin] instruction for students [for a school year before
- 9 the fourth Monday in August unless the district operates a
- 10 year-round system under Section 25.084].
- 11 [(b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a school district that
- 12 does not offer each grade level from kindergarten through grade 12
- 13 and whose prospective or former students generally attend school in
- 14 another state for the grade levels the district does not offer may
- 15 start school on any date permitted under Subsection (a) or the law
- 16 of the other state.
- SECTION 2. Section 7.056(e), Education Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 (e) Except as provided by Subsection (f), a school campus or
- 20 district may not receive an exemption or waiver under this section
- 21 from:
- 22 (1) a prohibition on conduct that constitutes a
- 23 criminal offense;
- 24 (2) a requirement imposed by federal law or rule,

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- 1 including a requirement for special education or bilingual
- 2 education programs; or
- 3 (3) a requirement, restriction, or prohibition
- 4 relating to:
- 5 (A) essential knowledge or skills under Section
- 6 28.002 or minimum graduation requirements under Section 28.025;
- 7 (B) public school accountability as provided by
- 8 Subchapters B, C, D, and G, Chapter 39;
- 9 (C) extracurricular activities under Section
- 10 33.081 or participation in a University Interscholastic League
- 11 area, regional, or state competition under Section 33.0812;
- 12 (D) health and safety under Chapter 38;
- (E) purchasing under Subchapter B, Chapter 44;
- 14 (F) elementary school class size limits, except
- 15 as provided by Section 25.112;
- 16 (G) removal of a disruptive student from the
- 17 classroom under Subchapter A, Chapter 37;
- 18 (H) at-risk programs under Subchapter C, Chapter
- 19 29;
- 20 (I) prekindergarten programs under Subchapter E,
- 21 Chapter 29;
- 22 (J) educator rights and benefits under
- 23 Subchapters A, C, D, E, F, G, and I, Chapter 21, or under Subchapter
- 24 A, Chapter 22;
- 25 (K) special education programs under Subchapter

- 4 SECTION 3. Section 25.084(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) A school district may operate its schools year-round on
- 7 either a single-track or a multitrack calendar. If a school
- 8 district adopts a year-round system, the district may modify:
- 9 (1) the number of contract days of employees and the
- 10 number of days of operation, including any time required for staff
- 11 development, planning and preparation, and continuing education,
- 12 otherwise required by law;
- 13 (2) testing dates, data reporting, and related
- 14 matters; and
- 15 (3) [the date of the first day of instruction of the
- 16 school year under Section 25.0811 for a school that was operating
- 17 year-round for the 2000-2001 school year; and
- 18 $\left[\frac{(4)}{a}\right]$ a student's eligibility to participate in
- 19 extracurricular activities when the student's calendar track is not
- 20 in session.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 22 school year.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
