AN ACT

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 112, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 112.011 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 112.011. ELECTRONIC CHECKING ACCOUNT TRANSACTION
- 8 REGISTER. (a) This section applies only to a county with a
- 9 population of 250,000 or more.

- 10 (b) The county treasurer shall maintain the transaction
- 11 register for the county's checking account in a searchable
- 12 <u>electronic spreadsheet format, such as a portable document format</u>
- 13 (PDF) or similar file type, in which the transaction register is
- 14 readily available for purposes of Subsection (d). Except as
- 15 provided by Subsection (c), the electronic checking account
- 16 transaction register must include for each check written from a
- 17 county checking account:
- 18 <u>(1) the transaction amount;</u>
- 19 (2) the name of the payee; and
- 20 (3) a statement of the purpose of the expenditure for
- 21 which the check was written.
- 22 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), beginning September
- 23 <u>1, 2010, a county's electronic checking account transaction</u>
- 24 register must contain the information required by Subsections

- 1 (b)(1) and (2) for each check dated on or after August 1, 2010.
- 2 Beginning September 1, 2011, a county's electronic checking account
- 3 transaction register must contain the information required by
- 4 Subsections (b)(1) through (3) for each check dated on or after
- 5 August 1, 2011. This subsection expires October 1, 2011.
- 6 (c) A county may not include in the county's electronic
- 7 checking account transaction register a check issued to a county
- 8 employee in payment of:
- 9 (1) salary, wages, or an employment stipend; or
- 10 (2) a workers' compensation income benefit, medical
- 11 benefit, death benefit, or burial benefit that is issued by a county
- 12 operating as a self-insurer under Chapter 504, Labor Code.
- 13 (d) A county shall post the electronic checking account
- 14 transaction register at all times on the county's Internet website
- 15 for viewing and downloading by interested persons. The county may
- 16 not charge a fee to a person who views or downloads the electronic
- 17 checking account transaction register under this subsection.
- 18 (e) A county shall:
- 19 (1) update the electronic checking account
- 20 transaction register at least once each month, not later than the
- 21 30th day after the closing date of the most recent monthly statement
- 22 for the checking account; and
- 23 (2) maintain each transaction or listing in the
- 24 electronic checking account transaction register on the county's
- 25 Internet website until the first anniversary of the date of the
- 26 transaction or listing.

- 3 (g) This section does not apply to a county that maintains a
- 4 <u>check registry or a similar comprehensive monthly financial report</u>
- 5 that was posted on the county's Internet website for public viewing
- 6 and downloading on or before August 1, 2010.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
