- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 801.362(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A veterinarian may dispense a drug, other than a
- 8 controlled substance, prescribed by another veterinarian,
- 9 <u>including a veterinarian licensed in another state</u>, if:
- 10 (1) failure to dispense the drug could interrupt a
- 11 therapeutic regimen or cause a patient to suffer;
- 12 (2) the prescribing veterinarian informs the
- 13 dispensing veterinarian that the drug is appropriate and necessary
- 14 for the animal;
- 15 (3) the quantity of the dispensed drug does not exceed
- 16 a five-day supply for each animal annually;
- 17 (4) the annual total of dosage units of drugs
- 18 dispensed under this subsection is not more than five percent of the
- 19 total dosage units of drugs the veterinarian dispenses in a year;
- 20 and
- 21 (5) the veterinarian maintains records of dispensing
- 22 activities under this section consistent with board rules.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
