- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 1701.3075 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1701.3075. QUALIFIED APPLICANT AWAITING APPOINTMENT.
- 9 (a) A person who meets the requirements set forth in Section
- 10 1701.307(a) has the same reporting responsibilities toward the
- 11 commission under rules adopted by the commission as a license
- 12 holder who has already been appointed as a peace officer.
- 13 (b) The commission may determine that a person who meets the
- 14 requirements under Section 1701.307(a) is ineligible for
- 15 appointment as a peace officer based on events that occur after the
- 16 person meets the requirements in Section 1701.307(a) but before the
- 17 person is appointed.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
