- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1305.002, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subdivision (14) to read as follows:
- 6 (14) "Journeyman lineman" means an individual who
- 7 engages in electrical work involving the maintenance and operation
- 8 of equipment associated with the transmission and distribution of
- 9 electricity from the electricity's original source to a substation
- 10 <u>for further distribution.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 1305.102(a), Occupations Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) The executive director shall adopt rules for the
- 14 licensing of electricians, sign electricians, electrical sign
- 15 contractors, electrical contractors, journeyman linemen,
- 16 residential appliance installers, and residential appliance
- 17 installation contractors as prescribed by this chapter.
- 18 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 1305, Occupations Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Section 1305.1605 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1305.1605. JOURNEYMAN LINEMAN. An applicant for a
- 21 license as a journeyman lineman must have:
- (1) at least 7,000 hours of training in an
- 23 apprenticeship program approved by the United States Department of
- 24 Labor; or

- 1 (2) at least 3-1/2 years of experience as a journeyman
- 2 lineman for an electric utility or electrical contractor in this
- 3 state.
- 4 SECTION 4. Section 1305.168(a), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) To renew a master electrician, journeyman electrician,
- 7 master sign electrician, journeyman sign electrician, maintenance
- 8 electrician, journeyman lineman, or residential wireman license,
- 9 the license holder must complete four hours of continuing education
- 10 annually.
- 11 SECTION 5. (a) Not later than January 1, 2010, the
- 12 executive director of the Texas Department of Licensing and
- 13 Regulation shall adopt rules regulating the licensing of a
- 14 journeyman lineman, as required by Section 1305.102, Occupations
- 15 Code, as amended by this Act.
- 16 (b) The executive director's rules under Subsection (a) of
- 17 this section must include rules that permit the issuance of a
- 18 license to an applicant who applies not later than June 1, 2010, and
- 19 presents evidence to the Texas Department of Licensing and
- 20 Regulation that the applicant has at least one year of experience as
- 21 a journeyman lineman for an electric utility or electrical
- 22 contractor in this state.
- 23 (c) A person is not required to hold a license as a
- 24 journeyman lineman under Chapter 1305, Occupations Code, as amended
- 25 by this Act, before June 1, 2010.
- 26 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
