H.B. No. 2823

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to eligible recipients of certain grants awarded by the
3 commissioner of education.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 29.917, Education Code, is amended by
6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
7 follows:

8 (a) From funds appropriated for the purpose, the
9 commissioner may award grants to organizations that provide
10 volunteers to teach classroom or after-school programs to students
11 enrolled in a school district or open-enrollment charter school to
12 enhance:

- 13 (1) college readiness;
14 (2) workforce readiness;
15 (3) dropout prevention; or
16 (4) personal financial literacy.

17 (d) This section does not authorize the commissioner to
18 award a grant to an organization to provide a comprehensive
19 educational program to students that serves as a substitute for a
20 regular educational program provided by a school district or
21 open-enrollment charter school. This section authorizes the
22 commissioner to award a grant to an organization only for the
23 provision of supplemental programs described by Subsection (a).

24 SECTION 2. Section 39.361(c), Education Code, is amended to

1 read as follows:

2 (c) To meet the goals of the council's strategic plan, the
3 ~~[The]~~ commissioner of education or the commissioner of higher
4 education, as applicable, shall consider the council's
5 recommendations and based on those recommendations may award grants
6 listed in Subsection (a) to school districts, open-enrollment
7 charter schools, institutions of higher education, regional
8 education service centers, and nonprofit organizations that
9 provide technical assistance, professional development,
10 case-managed student services, and programs for the benefit of
11 students enrolled in school districts or open-enrollment charter
12 schools ~~[to meet the goals of the council's strategic plan].~~

13 SECTION 3. Subchapter L, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
14 amended by adding Section 39.367 to read as follows:

15 Sec. 39.367. CERTAIN GRANTS TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS NOT
16 AUTHORIZED. This subchapter does not authorize the commissioner to
17 award a grant to a nonprofit organization for services provided as a
18 private school or to a private school.

19 SECTION 4. It is the intent of the legislature that the
20 grants that may not be awarded to an organization or nonprofit
21 organization under Sections 29.917(d) and 39.367, Education Code,
22 as added by this Act, include dropout recovery grants, such as the
23 grants awarded in 2008 in response to the Texas Education Agency's
24 Request for Applications (RFA) 701-08-116.

25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
