A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to transferring to the property tax relief fund one-half of any unencumbered balance of general revenue at the end of a state 3 fiscal biennium. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 403.109, Government Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: (e) In addition to amounts deposited to the credit of the 8 property tax relief fund under other law, the comptroller shall, 9 not later than the 90th day of each state fiscal biennium, transfer 10 to the property tax relief fund one-half of any unencumbered 11 positive balance of general revenues on the last day of the 12 preceding state fiscal biennium. For purposes of this subsection, 13 14 general revenues are considered encumbered on the last day of a state fiscal biennium only to the extent that general revenues are 15 subject to payment for particular identifiable and legally 16 enforceable obligations of this state that were incurred on or 17 before that day and intended to be paid out of appropriations for 18 19 that biennium. SECTION 2. Section 403.109(e), Government Code, as added by 20

20 SECTION 2. Section 403.109(e), Government Code, as added by 21 this Act, applies beginning with the unencumbered positive balance 22 of general revenues in the state treasury on the last day of the 23 state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2009.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 4 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 5 legislative session.
