5	SECTION 1. Part 6, Chapter VII, Texas Probate Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 246 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 246. ALLOWANCE FOR DEFENDING CERTAIN ACTIONS. (a) A
8	person designated as executor in a decedent's will shall be allowed
9	out of the estate the person's necessary expenses and
10	disbursements, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred in
11	defending a proceeding that:
12	(1) is brought against the person in the person's
13	former capacity as the decedent's agent under a durable power of
14	attorney; and
15	(2) involves property of the decedent's estate.
16	(b) A person designated as a devisee in or beneficiary of a
17	decedent's will shall be allowed out of the estate the person's
18	necessary expenses and disbursements, including reasonable
19	attorney's fees, incurred in prosecuting a proceeding described by
20	Subsection (a) of this section that is brought by the person in good
21	faith and with just cause.
22	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
23	a proceeding that is instituted on or after the effective date of
24	this Act.
