- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 263.153, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A county that contracts with an auctioneer licensed
- 8 under Chapter 1802, Occupations Code, who uses an Internet auction
- 9 site offering online bidding through the Internet to sell surplus
- 10 or salvage property under this subchapter shall satisfy the notice
- 11 requirement under this section by posting the property on the site
- 12 for at least 10 days unless the property is sold before the 10th
- 13 <u>day</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
