- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article 102.006, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Art. 102.006. FEES IN EXPUNCTION PROCEEDINGS. (a) In
- 7 addition to any other fees required by other law, a petitioner
- 8 seeking expunction of a criminal record shall pay the following
- 9 fees:
- 10 (1) except as provided by Subsection (b), the fee
- 11 charged for filing an ex parte petition in a civil action in
- 12 district court;
- 13 (2) \$1 plus postage for each certified mailing of
- 14 notice of the hearing date; and
- 15 (3) \$2 plus postage for each certified mailing of
- 16 certified copies of an order of expunction.
- 17 (b) The fee under Subsection (a)(1) shall be waived if:
- 18 (1) the petitioner seeks expunction of a criminal
- 19 record that relates to an arrest for an offense of which the person
- 20 was acquitted, other than an acquittal for an offense described by
- 21 Article 55.01(c); and
- 22 (2) the petition for expunction is filed not later
- 23 than the 30th day after the date of the acquittal.
- 24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

- 1 to a petition for expunction filed on or after the effective date of
- 2 this Act. A petition for expunction filed before the effective date
- 3 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the petition
- 4 was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 5 purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
