- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 240, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 240.909 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 240.909. REGULATION OF TREE CUTTING IN CERTAIN
- 8 COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a county with a
- 9 population of 25,000 or less that borders the Gulf of Mexico and in
- 10 which is located at least one state park and one national wildlife
- 11 refuge.
- 12 (b) The commissioners court of a county subject to this
- 13 <u>section may prohibit or restrict the clear-cutting of live oak</u>
- 14 trees in the unincorporated area of the county.
- 15 (c) A person commits an offense if the person violates an
- 16 order adopted under this section and the order defines the
- 17 violation as an offense. An offense under this section is
- 18 prosecuted in the same manner as an offense defined under state law.
- 19 <u>(d) The county attorney or an attorney representing the</u>
- 20 county may file an action in district court to enjoin a violation or
- 21 threatened violation of an order adopted under this section. The
- 22 court may grant appropriate relief.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
