7	APPLICABLE TO CROP INSURANCE
8	Sec. 1806.201. PROHIBITED ACTS. An insurer or agent that is
9	authorized to engage in the business of insurance that is limited to
10	the business of insuring risks on growing crops may not participate
11	in an arrangement that allows a person to receive or potentially
12	receive a dividend, profit, or other consideration that is
13	contingent solely on the purchase of that insurance.
14	SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an insurance policy or
15	contract that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or
16	after January 1, 2010. An insurance policy or contract delivered,
