## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to placement in a disciplinary alternative education
- 3 program of a student younger than 10 years of age who engages in
- 4 conduct for which expulsion is mandatory.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37.006(f), Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (f) Subject to Section 37.007(e), a student who is younger
- 9 than 10 years of age shall be removed from class and placed in a
- 10 disciplinary alternative education program under Section 37.008 if
- 11 the student engages in conduct described by Section 37.007(a) or
- 12 (d) that requires expulsion of a student who is at least 10 years of
- 13  $\underline{\text{age}}$  [37.007]. An elementary school student may not be placed in a
- 14 disciplinary alternative education program with any other student
- 15 who is not an elementary school student.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
