A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to allowing a governmental body to redact certain personal
- 3 information under the public information law without the necessity
- 4 of requesting a decision from the attorney general and the
- 5 calculation of certain deadlines under the public information law.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 552.024(c), Government Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (c) If the employee or official or former employee or
- 10 official chooses not to allow public access to the information or if
- 11 the information is excepted under Section 552.117 without regard to
- 12 whether the person complies with this section:
- 13 (1) $[\tau]$ the information is protected under Subchapter
- 14 C; and

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- 15 (2) the governmental body may redact the information
- 16 from any information the governmental body discloses under Section
- 17 552.021 without the necessity of requesting a decision from the
- 18 attorney general under Subchapter G.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 552.1175, Government Code, is amended by
- 20 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 21 (f) A governmental body may redact information that must be
- 22 withheld under Subsection (b) from any information the governmental
- 23 body discloses under Section 552.021 without the necessity of
- 24 requesting a decision from the attorney general under Subchapter G.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 552.130, Government Code, is amended by
- 2 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 (c) Subject to Chapter 730, Transportation Code, a
- 4 governmental body may redact information described by Subsection
- 5 (a) from any information the governmental body discloses under
- 6 Section 552.021 without the necessity of requesting a decision from
- 7 the attorney general under Subchapter G.
- 8 SECTION 4. Section 552.136, Government Code, is amended by
- 9 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 10 (c) A governmental body may redact information that must be
- 11 withheld under Subsection (b) from any information the governmental
- 12 body discloses under Section 552.021 without the necessity of
- 13 requesting a decision from the attorney general under Subchapter G.
- 14 SECTION 5. Section 552.137, Government Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 16 (e) A governmental body may redact information that may be
- 17 withheld under this section from any information the governmental
- 18 body discloses under Section 552.021 without the necessity of
- 19 requesting a decision from the attorney general under Subchapter G.
- SECTION 6. Section 552.138, Government Code, is amended by
- 21 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (c) A governmental body may redact information maintained
- 23 by a family violence shelter center or sexual assault program that
- 24 may be withheld under Subsection (b)(1) or (6) from any information
- 25 the governmental body discloses under Section 552.021 without the
- 26 necessity of requesting a decision from the attorney general under
- 27 Subchapter G.

- 1 SECTION 7. Section 552.263, Government Code, is amended by
- 2 adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 3 (e-1) If a requestor modifies the request in response to the
- 4 requirement of a deposit or bond authorized by this section, the
- 5 modified request is considered a separate request for the purposes
- 6 of this chapter and is considered received on the date the
- 7 governmental body receives the written modified request.
- 8 SECTION 8. Section 552.301, Government Code, is amended by
- 9 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 10 <u>(a-1)</u> For the purposes of this subchapter, if a governmental
- 11 body receives a written request by the United States mail and cannot
- 12 adequately establish the actual date on which the governmental body
- 13 <u>received the request, the written request is considered to have</u>
- 14 been received by the governmental body on the third business day
- 15 after the date of the postmark on a properly addressed request.
- 16 SECTION 9. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections
- 17 552.263 and 552.301, Government Code, apply only to a request for
- 18 information that is received by a governmental body or an officer
- 19 for public information on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 A request for information that was received before the effective
- 21 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 22 request was received, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 23 that purpose.
- 24 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
