7	Sec. 22.008. NOTICE OF LEAVE POLICY. (a) A school district
8	shall provide written notice to any district employee regarding the
9	types of leave the employee is entitled to while employed by the
10	district. The notice must include:
11	(1) an explanation of the district's policies
12	regarding leave; and
13	(2) a description of:
14	(A) the personal leave the employee is entitled
15	to as provided by Section 22.003;
16	(B) the leave allowed for jury service as
17	provided by Section 22.006; and
18	(C) the leave allowed for complying with a
19	subpoena as provided by Section 52.051(a), Labor Code.
20	(b) If the employee is an educator certified under Chapter
21	21, the notice must also include a description of leave allowed for:
22	(1) observance of a religious holiday as provided by
23	Section 21.406;
24	(2) a temporary disability as provided by Section

2 (3) training and developmental purposes as provided by
3 Section 21.452.

4 (c) The notice required by this section must be given to a
5 school district employee not later than the 10th day after the date
6 the employee is hired by the district.

7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
