Section 651.001, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (10-a) to read as follows: 6 7 (10-a) "Funeral vehicle escort service" means a business that facilitates the movement of traffic for a funeral 8 9 procession through the streets and highways of the state. SECTION 2. Chapter 651, Occupations Code, is amended by 10 11 adding Subchapter H-1 to read as follows: 12 SUBCHAPTER H-1. LICENSE REQUIREMENTS: FUNERAL VEHICLE ESCORT 13 SERVICES 14 Sec. 651.381. FUNERAL VEHICLE ESCORT SERVICE LICENSE REQUIREMENT. A person may not facilitate the movement of traffic 15 16 for a funeral procession unless the person is: (1) a funeral vehicle escort service licensed under 17 this subchapter; or 18 (2) an employee of a funeral vehicle escort service 19 20 licensed under this subchapter. Sec. 651.382. RULES. (a) The commission shall adopt rules 21 to administer this subchapter. 22 23 (b) Rules adopted under this section must include provisions requiring that: 24

1	(1) a vehicle escorting a funeral procession:
2	(A) must be clearly and visibly marked with the

4	(B) may not be equipped with:

17	operation of an emergency vehicle or law enforcement vehicle.
18	SECTION 3. Chapter 546, Transportation Code, is amended by
19	adding Subchapter C to read as follows:
20	SUBCHAPTER C. AUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN OTHER VEHICLES
21	Sec. 546.031. FUNERAL VEHICLE ESCORT SERVICES. (a) An
22	operator of a vehicle facilitating the movement of a funeral

24	Subchapter H-1, Occupations Code, or an employee of a licensed
25	funeral vehicle escort service may proceed past a red or stop signal
26	or stop sign, after slowing as necessary for safe operation.

1 escort vehicle from: (1) the duty to operate the vehicle with appropriate 2 3 regard for the safety of all persons; or 4 (2) the consequences of reckless disregard for the 5 safety of others. 6 SECTION 4. Section 707.009, Transportation Code, is amended 7 to read as follows: 8 Sec. 707.009. REQUIRED ORDINANCE PROVISIONS. (a) An ordinance adopted under Section 707.002 must provide that a person 9 10 against whom the local authority seeks to impose a civil penalty is entitled to a hearing and shall: 11 12 (1)provide for the period in which the hearing must be 13 held; 14 (2) provide for the appointment of a hearing officer 15 with authority to administer oaths and issue orders compelling the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; and 16 17 (3) designate the department, agency, or office of the local authority responsible for the enforcement and administration 18 19 of the ordinance or provide that the entity with which the local authority contracts under Section 707.003(a)(1) is responsible for 20 the enforcement and administration of the ordinance. 21 (b) An ordinance adopted under Section 707.002 may not 22 impose a civil penalty on an owner of a vehicle operated in 23 24 violation of the instructions of a traffic-control signal, as specified by Section 544.007(d), if the person is accompanied by a 25 26 funeral vehicle escort service licensed under Subchapter H-1, Occupations Code, or an employee of a licensed funeral vehicle 27

2 SECTION 5. Not later than January 1, 2010, the Texas Funeral 3 Service Commission shall adopt rules required under Section 4 651.382, Occupations Code, as added by this Act.

5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
