A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to authorizing an increase in the student center fee at

- 3 Texas Southern University.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 54.522(a), (c), and (e), Education
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The board of regents of Texas Southern University may
- 8 impose on each student enrolled in the university [levy and
- 9 $\frac{\text{collect}}{\text{collect}}$ a student fee not to exceed $\frac{\$75}{\text{collect}}$ per student for each
- 10 semester of the regular term [long session] and not to exceed \$37.50
- 11 [\$17.50] per student for each summer term [of the summer session,
- 12 from each student enrolled in Texas Southern University], as the
- 13 <u>board determines</u> [may in its discretion be just and] necessary for
- 14 the purpose of operating, maintaining, improving, and equipping the
- 15 student center and acquiring or constructing additions to the
- 16 student center. A fee collected under this section is in addition
- 17 to any other use or service fee authorized to be imposed [levied].
- 18 (c) The student fee advisory committee annually shall
- 19 submit to the board of regents a complete and itemized budget for
- 20 the student center with a complete report of all student center
- 21 activities conducted during the past year and all expenditures made
- 22 in connection with those activities. The board of regents may make
- 23 changes in the budget that the board determines are necessary.
- 24 After approving the budget, the board of regents, in accordance

- 1 with this section, may \underline{impose} [levy] the student center fees for
- 2 that year in amounts sufficient to meet the budgetary needs of the
- 3 student center.
- 4 (e) A fee <u>imposed</u> [levied] under this section may not be
- 5 considered in determining the maximum student services fee that may
- 6 be charged under Section 54.503(b).
- 7 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 8 beginning with student fees charged by a public institution of
- 9 higher education for the 2009-2010 academic year. Student fees
- 10 charged by a public institution of higher education for an academic
- 11 year before that academic year are covered by the law in effect
- 12 before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is
- 13 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
