Section 25.087(b), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) A school district shall excuse a student from attending school for: 8 9 (1) the following purposes, including travel for those 10 purposes: 11 (A) observing religious holy days; or 12 (B) attending a required court appearance; or 13 a temporary absence for the following purposes, (2) [resulting from health care professionals] if that student 14 commences classes or returns to school on the same day as the 15 16 temporary absence: (A) attending an appointment with a health care 17 professional; or 18 (B) voting in a national, state, or local 19 election [of the appointment]. 20 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010 22 school year. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24

Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
