A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to licensing of assisted living facilities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 247.021, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsections (d), (g), and (h) and adding
- 6 Subsections (d-1), (d-2), (d-3), and (d-4) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The department by rule shall establish procedures to
- 8 issue a six-month provisional license to existing facilities with
- 9 residents. The department may issue a provisional license [only]
- 10 if:
- 11 (1) the facility is in compliance with resident care
- 12 standards;
- 13 (2) the facility voluntarily discloses that the
- 14 facility needs additional time to comply with life safety code and
- 15 physical plant standards;
- 16 (3) the disclosure is made in writing by certified
- 17 mail to the department;
- 18 (4) an investigation of the violation was not
- 19 initiated and the violation was not independently detected by the
- 20 department; and
- 21 (5) the disclosure is made promptly after knowledge of
- 22 the information disclosed is obtained by the facility.
- 23 (d-1) A provisional license is effective on the date
- 24 requested by the applicant.

- 1 (d-2) A provisional license expires the earlier of:
- 2 <u>(1) the 180th day after the effective date of the</u>
- 3 provisional license or the end of any extension period granted by
- 4 the department, in the department's sole discretion; or
- 5 (2) the date a license is issued to the provisional
- 6 license holder under Subsection (d-4).
- 7 (d-3) The department shall conduct a life safety code
- 8 inspection of the facility as soon as reasonably possible after the
- 9 department issues a provisional license.
- 10 (d-4) After conducting a life safety code inspection, the
- 11 department shall issue a license under Section 247.023 to the
- 12 provisional license holder if the facility passes the inspection
- 13 and the applicant meets all requirements for a license. A license
- 14 issued under this subsection has the same effective date as the
- 15 provisional license.
- 16 (g) The [Notwithstanding Subsection (f), the] department
- 17 shall, upon submission of a written request by the applicant, [may]
- 18 automatically issue a provisional license to a newly constructed
- 19 facility if:
- 20 (1) the facility is in compliance with resident care
- 21 standards;
- 22 (2) all local approvals have been obtained;
- 23 (3) a complete license application is submitted within
- 24 30 days of receipt of all local approvals; [and]
- 25 (4) the license fee has been paid;
- 26 (5) before beginning construction, the license
- 27 applicant submits working drawings and specifications to the

- 1 <u>department for review; and</u>
- 2 (6) the department determines that the license
- 3 applicant constructed another facility in this state that complies
- 4 with the department's life safety code standards.
- 5 (h) The [Notwithstanding Subsection (f), the] department
- 6 may automatically issue a provisional license in the case of a
- 7 corporate change of ownership of a facility.
- 8 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
- 9 Code, is amended by adding Section 247.0211 to read as follows:
- Sec. 247.0211. EXPEDITED LIFE SAFETY CODE INSPECTION. (a)
- 11 The executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services
- 12 Commission shall adopt rules to implement an expedited inspection
- 13 process that allows an applicant for an assisted living facility
- 14 license or for a renewal of a license to obtain a life safety code
- 15 and physical plant inspection not later than the 15th day after the
- 16 <u>date the request is made.</u>
- 17 (b) The department may charge a fee to recover the cost of
- 18 the expedited inspection.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 247.022, Health and Safety Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 21 (b-1) If the department conducts at least three life safety
- 22 code inspections at the applicant's facility, the department may
- 23 collect a fee in addition to the fee under Subsection (b) for the
- 24 application for the license.
- 25 SECTION 4. Section 247.032(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- 27 (a) In this section, "accreditation commission" means the

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- 1 Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, [or) the
- 2 Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations, or
- 3 another organization approved by the executive commissioner of the
- 4 Health and Human Services Commission.
- 5 SECTION 5. Sections 247.021(e) and (f), Health and Safety
- 6 Code, are repealed.
- 7 SECTION 6. Not later than January 1, 2010, the executive
- 8 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 9 adopt rules to implement the expedited inspection process as
- 10 required by Section 247.0211, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 11 this Act.
- 12 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
