6	SECTION 1. Chapter 32, Education Code, is amended by adding
7	Subchapter G to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER G. TECHNOLOGY ENDOWMENT FUND
9	Sec. 32.301. ESTABLISHMENT OF TECHNOLOGY ENDOWMENT FUND.
10	(a) A permanent technology endowment fund is established as a
11	special fund in the treasury outside the general revenue fund.
12	(b) The technology endowment fund consists of:
13	(1) money transferred to the fund at the direction of
14	the legislature;
15	(2) gifts and grants contributed to the fund; and
16	(3) income from investment of money in the fund.
17	(c) The fund may be invested by the commissioner in
18	securities, bonds, and other investments that the commissioner
19	considers prudent. In making investments under this subsection,
20	the commissioner shall exercise the judgment and care under the
21	circumstances then prevailing that a person of ordinary prudence,
22	discretion, and intelligence exercises in the management of the
23	person's own affairs.

- 7 district under this section only for a purpose permitted under
