- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 12, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 12.137 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12.137. ACCOUNTABILITY OF CERTAIN OPEN-ENROLLMENT
- 8 CHARTER SCHOOLS. (a) In this section, "student at high risk of
- 9 dropping out of school" means a student who:
- 10 (1) meets three or more of the criteria provided by
- 11 Section 29.081(d); or

- 12 (2) is at least 21 years of age but less than 26 years
- 13 of age and otherwise meets at least one of the criteria provided by
- 14 <u>Section 29.081(d).</u>
- 15 (b) This section applies only to an open-enrollment charter
- 16 school offering a high school curriculum in which 85 percent or more
- of the students enrolled in the school on the date specified by the
- 18 agency are students at high risk of dropping out of school.
- 19 (c) An open-enrollment charter school to which this section
- 20 applies is not required to include the performance of a student at
- 21 high risk of dropping out of school in any accountability report
- 22 until the 180th day after the date the student first enrolls in the
- 23 school. For purposes of this subsection, "accountability report"
- 24 includes a report required under the academic excellence indicator

- 3 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
