A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to the fees for certain license plates.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 504.003, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (c) If <u>a</u> [the] souvenir license plate <u>issued before</u>
- 8 September 1, 2009, is personalized, the fee for the plate is
- 9 \$40. Of the fee:
- 10 (1) \$20 shall be deposited to the credit of the state
- 11 highway fund;
- 12 (2) \$10 shall be deposited to the credit of the
- 13 designated account if the souvenir license plate is a replica of a
- 14 specialty license plate issued under Subchapter G or I for which the
- 15 fee is deposited to a designated account other than the state
- 16 highway fund; and
- 17 (3) the remainder shall be deposited to the credit of
- 18 the general revenue fund.
- 19 (c-1) The fee for a souvenir license plate issued on or
- 20 after September 1, 2009, is the amount established under Section
- 21 <u>504.851(c).</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 504.102, Transportation Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- Sec. 504.102. PERSONALIZATION OF [OTHER] SPECIALTY LICENSE

- 1 PLATE [PLATES]. Unless expressly prohibited by this chapter or
- 2 department rule, any specialty license plate issued under this
- 3 chapter may be personalized. If \underline{a} [another] specialty license
- 4 plate is personalized, the fee for personalization of the specialty
- 5 license plate [established by Section 504.101(c)] shall be added to
- 6 the fee for issuance of that specialty license plate.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 504.601, Transportation Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 504.601. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO [ALL]
- 10 SPECIALTY LICENSE PLATES FOR GENERAL DISTRIBUTION. (a) Unless
- 11 expressly provided by this subchapter or department rule:
- 12 (1) the fee for issuance of a license plate under this
- 13 subchapter is \$30; and
- 14 (2) of each fee received under this subchapter, the
- 15 department shall use \$8 to defray its administrative costs in
- 16 complying with this subchapter.
- 17 (b) This section does not apply to a specialty license plate
- 18 marketed and sold by a private vendor at the request of the
- 19 specialty license plate sponsor under Section 504.6011.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter G, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
- 21 is amended by adding Section 504.6011 to read as follows:
- Sec. 504.6011. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO SPECIALTY
- 23 LICENSE PLATES FOR GENERAL DISTRIBUTION SOLD THROUGH PRIVATE
- 24 VENDOR. (a) The sponsor of a specialty license plate authorized to
- 25 be issued under this subchapter before September 1, 2009, may
- 26 contract with the private vendor authorized under Subchapter J for
- 27 the marketing and sale of the specialty license plate.

- 1 (b) The fee for issuance of a specialty license plate
- 2 described by Subsection (a) is the amount established under Section
- 3 504.851.
- 4 (c) Notwithstanding any other law, from each fee received
- 5 for the issuance of a specialty license plate described by
- 6 Subsection (a), the department shall:
- 7 (1) deduct the administrative costs described by
- 8 Section 504.601(a)(2);
- 9 (2) deposit to the credit of the account designated by
- 10 the law authorizing the specialty license plate the portion of the
- 11 fee for the sale of the plate that the state would ordinarily
- 12 receive under the contract described by Section 504.851(a); and
- 13 (3) pay to the private vendor the remainder of the fee.
- SECTION 5. Section 504.801, Transportation Code, is amended
- 15 by amending Subsections (d), (e), and (f) and adding Subsection
- 16 (d-1) to read as follows:
- 17 (d) The fee for issuance of license plates created
- 18 [authorized] under this subchapter before September 1, 2009, is \$30
- 19 unless the department sets a higher fee. This subsection does not
- 20 apply to a specialty license plate marketed and sold by a private
- 21 vendor at the request of the specialty license plate sponsor.
- 22 (d-1) The fee for issuance of license plates created under
- 23 this subchapter on or after September 1, 2009, is the amount
- 24 established under Section 504.851.
- (e) For each fee collected for a license plate issued by the
- 26 department under this section:
- 27 (1) \$8 shall be used to reimburse the department for

- 1 its administrative costs; and
- 2 (2) the remainder shall be deposited to the credit of:
- 3 (A) the specialty license plate fund, which is an
- 4 account in the general revenue fund, if the sponsor nominated a
- 5 state agency to receive the funds; or
- 6 (B) the state highway fund if the sponsor did not
- 7 nominate a state agency to receive the funds or if there is no
- 8 sponsor.
- 9 (f) Subchapter D, Chapter 316, Government Code, and Section
- 10 403.095, Government Code, do not apply to fees collected under this
- 11 subchapter [section].
- 12 SECTION 6. Subchapter I, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
- 13 is amended by adding Section 504.802 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 504.802. MARKETING AND SALE BY PRIVATE VENDOR OF
- 15 SPECIALTY LICENSE PLATES CREATED BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2009. (a) A
- 16 sponsor of a specialty license plate created under this subchapter
- 17 before September 1, 2009, may contract with the private vendor
- 18 authorized under Subchapter J for the marketing and sale of the
- 19 specialty license plate.
- 20 (b) The fee for issuance of a specialty license plate
- 21 described by Subsection (a) is the amount established under Section
- 22 504.851(c).
- 23 (c) Notwithstanding any other law, from each fee received
- 24 from the issuance of a specialty license plate marketed and sold by
- 25 the private vendor under this section, the department shall:
- 26 (1) deduct the administrative costs described by
- 27 Section 504.801(e)(1);

- 1 (2) deposit the portion of the fee for the sale of the
- 2 plate that the state would ordinarily receive under the contract
- 3 described by Section 504.851(a) to the credit of:
- 4 (A) the specialty license plate fund, if the
- 5 sponsor nominated a state agency to receive the funds; or
- 6 (B) the state highway fund, if the sponsor did
- 7 not nominate a state agency to receive the funds or if there is no
- 8 sponsor; and
- 9 (3) pay to the private vendor the remainder of the fee.
- SECTION 7. Section 504.851, Transportation Code, is amended
- 11 by amending Subsections (a), (b), (c), (d), and (j) and adding
- 12 Subsections (a-1), (a-2), and (c-1) to read as follows:
- 13 (a) The department shall enter into a contract with the
- 14 private vendor whose proposal is most advantageous to the state, as
- 15 determined from competitive sealed proposals that satisfy the
- 16 requirements of this section, for the marketing and sale of:
- 17 (1) personalized license plates [authorized by
- 18 Section 504.101]; or
- 19 (2) with the agreement of the private vendor, other
- 20 specialty license plates authorized by this chapter [subchapter].
- 21 <u>(a-1)</u> The department may not issue license plates with
- 22 background colors other than white, unless the plates are marketed
- 23 and sold by the private vendor.
- 24 (a-2) Specialty license plates authorized for marketing and
- 25 sale under Subsection (a) must include:
- 26 (1) specialty license plates created under
- 27 Subchapters G and I on or after September 1, 2009; and

- 1 (2) at the request of the specialty license plate
- 2 sponsor, an existing specialty license plate created under
- 3 Subchapters G and I before September 1, 2009.
- 4 (b) The director [Instead of the fees established by Section
- 5 $\frac{504.101(c)}{c}$, the commission] by rule shall establish fees for the
- 6 issuance or renewal of personalized license plates that are
- 7 marketed and sold by the private vendor. Fees must be reasonable
- 8 and not less than the greater of:
- 9 (1) the amounts necessary to allow the department to
- 10 recover all reasonable costs to the department associated with the
- 11 evaluation of the competitive sealed proposals received by the
- 12 department and with the implementation and enforcement of the
- 13 contract, including direct, indirect, and administrative costs; or
- 14 (2) the amount established by Section <u>504.853(b)</u>
- 15 [504.101(c)].
- 16 (c) The director [commission] by rule shall establish the
- 17 fees for the issuance or renewal of souvenir license plates,
- 18 specialty license plates, or souvenir or specialty license plates
- 19 that are personalized that are marketed and sold by the private
- 20 vendor. Fees must be reasonable and not less than the amounts
- 21 necessary to allow the department to recover all reasonable costs
- 22 to the department associated with the evaluation of the competitive
- 23 sealed proposals received by the department and with the
- 24 implementation and enforcement of the contract, including direct,
- 25 indirect, and administrative costs. A fee established under this
- 26 subsection is in addition to:
- 27 (1) the registration fee and any optional registration

- 1 fee prescribed by this chapter for the vehicle for which specialty
- 2 license plates are issued;
- 3 (2) any additional fee prescribed by this subchapter
- 4 for the issuance of specialty license plates for that vehicle; and
- 5 (3) any additional fee prescribed by this subchapter
- 6 for the issuance of personalized license plates for that vehicle.
- 7 (c-1) Subsections (b) and (c) do not apply to the sale at
- 8 <u>auction of a license to display an alphanumeric pattern.</u>
- 9 (d) At any time as necessary to comply with Subsection (b)
- 10 or (c), the <u>director</u> [commission] may increase [or decrease] the
- 11 amount of a fee established under the applicable subsection.
- 12 (j) From amounts received by the department under the
- 13 contract described by Subsection (a), the department shall deposit
- 14 to the credit of the state highway fund an amount sufficient to
- 15 enable the department to recover its administrative costs for all
- 16 license plates issued under this section, [including] any payments
- 17 to the vendor under the contract [Subsection (a)], and any other
- 18 amounts allocated by law to the state highway fund [by another law].
- 19 To the extent that the disposition of other amounts received by
- 20 [from] the department is [vendor are] governed by another law,
- 21 those amounts shall be deposited in accordance with the other law.
- 22 The fee $[\frac{1}{2}]$ for each type of license plate issued under this
- 23 <u>chapter</u> [the amount charged for the license plate] may not be less
- 24 than the fee [amount] in effect on January 1, 2003. Any additional
- 25 amount received by [from] the department under the contract
- 26 [vendor] shall be deposited to the credit of the state highway
- 27 [general revenue] fund.

- 1 SECTION 8. Subchapter J, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
- 2 is amended by adding Sections 504.853, 504.854, and 504.855 to read
- 3 as follows:
- 4 Sec. 504.853. PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES ISSUED BEFORE
- 5 SEPTEMBER 1, 2009. (a) A personalized license plate issued before
- 6 September 1, 2009, may be issued for a subsequent registration
- 7 period only if the applicant submits an application and pays the
- 8 required fee for the applicable registration period. A person who
- 9 is issued a personalized license plate has first priority on that
- 10 license plate for each subsequent registration period for which the
- 11 person submits a new application for that plate.
- 12 (b) The fee for issuance of a personalized license plate
- 13 issued before September 1, 2009, is \$40, unless the director adopts
- 14 by rule a higher fee.
- 15 (c) A person who is issued a personalized license plate by
- 16 the department before September 1, 2009, may:
- 17 (1) submit an application for the plate under
- 18 Subsection (a) and pay the required fee for each subsequent
- 19 registration period under Subsection (b); or
- 20 (2) purchase through the private vendor a license to
- 21 display the alphanumeric pattern on a license plate for any term
- 22 allowed by law.
- 23 <u>(d) The department may not issue a replacement set of</u>
- 24 personalized license plates to the same person before the sixth
- 25 <u>anniversary of the date of issuance unless the applicant for</u>
- 26 issuance of replacement plates pays an additional fee of \$30.
- (e) Of each fee collected by the department under this

- 1 section:
- 2 (1) \$1.25 shall be used to defray the cost of
- 3 administering this section; and
- 4 (2) the remainder shall be deposited to the credit of
- 5 the general revenue fund.
- 6 Sec. 504.854. PERPETUAL LICENSE TO DISPLAY CERTAIN
- 7 ALPHANUMERIC PATTERNS. (a) A person may purchase through the
- 8 private vendor a perpetual license to display a unique alphanumeric
- 9 pattern on a license plate.
- 10 (b) A license to display an alphanumeric pattern purchased
- 11 under this section may be transferred to another person. The
- 12 transferee is entitled to the same rights and privileges as the
- 13 transferor.
- 14 (c) The transferee shall file a form prescribed by the
- 15 department to notify the department of the transfer.
- Sec. 504.855. AUCTION. (a) The private vendor may sell at
- 17 auction a license to display an alphanumeric pattern.
- 18 (b) A person who purchases a license to display an
- 19 alphanumeric pattern at auction is entitled to the same rights and
- 20 privileges as a person who purchases a license plate or a license to
- 21 display an alphanumeric pattern under Section 504.854.
- 22 SECTION 9. The following provisions of the Transportation
- 23 Code are repealed:
- 24 (1) Section 504.101; and
- 25 (2) Section 504.851(m).
- 26 SECTION 10. The changes in law made by this Act do not
- 27 require the rebidding of a contract that is in effect on the

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- 1 effective date of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 11. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
