- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1701.3161, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1701.3161. REACTIVATION OF PEACE OFFICER LICENSE:
- 8 RETIRED PEACE OFFICERS AND HOLDERS OF CERTAIN PROFICIENCY
- 9 CERTIFICATES. (a) In this section, "retired peace officer" means
- 10 a person who served as a peace officer in this state who:
- 11 (1) is not currently serving as an elected, appointed,
- 12 or employed peace officer under Article 2.12, Code of Criminal
- 13 Procedure, or other law;
- 14 (2) was eligible to retire from a law enforcement
- 15 agency in this state or was ineligible to retire only as a result of
- 16 an injury received in the course of the officer's employment with
- 17 the law enforcement agency; and
- 18 (3) is eligible to receive a pension or annuity for
- 19 service as a law enforcement officer in this state or is ineligible
- 20 to receive a pension or annuity only because the law enforcement
- 21 agency that employed the officer does not offer a pension or annuity
- 22 to its employees.
- 23 (b) The commission shall adopt rules for the reactivation
- 24 after a break in employment of the [a retired peace officer's]

- 1 license of a retired peace officer or of a person previously
- 2 licensed as a peace officer who holds an advanced proficiency
- 3 <u>certificate under Section 1701.402</u> [after a break in employment].
- 4 The rules must allow a retired peace officer or a person previously
- 5 licensed as a peace officer who holds an advanced proficiency
- 6 <u>certificate</u> to reactivate the officer's license by completing the
- 7 continuing education requirements prescribed by Section 1701.351
- 8 and completing any other continuing education requirement imposed
- 9 by law in lieu of successfully completing any examination required
- 10 by the commission for reactivation.
- 11 (c) The commission may waive the reinstatement fee
- 12 established for the reactivation of a peace officer's license for a
- 13 retired peace officer or a person previously licensed as a peace
- 14 officer who holds an advanced proficiency certificate under Section
- 15 <u>1701.402</u> who is eligible for reactivation as provided by Subsection
- 16 (b).
- 17 (d) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), a person previously
- 18 licensed as a peace officer who holds an advanced proficiency
- 19 <u>certificate under Section 1701.402</u> is ineligible for reactivation
- 20 of a peace officer license under this section if the person's peace
- 21 officer license was previously revoked.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
