1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the consideration of longevity and cost of living in  
1-9 setting the salaries for certain municipal employees.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 141, Local Government  
1-12 Code, is amended by adding Section 141.010 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 141.010. MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES IN TYPE A AND B  
1-14 GENERAL-LAW MUNICIPALITIES. To the extent consistent with  
1-15 Subchapter B of this chapter and Chapters 142 and 143, the governing  
1-16 body of a Type A or B general-law municipality may consider  
1-17 longevity and cost of living in setting the salary of a municipal  
1-18 employee.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
