1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the creation of a bail bond board by the commissioners  
1-9 court of certain counties.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 1704.052, Occupations Code, is amended  
1-12 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 1704.052. DISCRETIONARY CREATION OF BOARD. A board  
1-14 may be created in a county with a population of less than 110,000  
1-15 if:

1-16 (1) a majority of the persons who would serve as  
1-17 members of the board under Section 1704.053, or who would designate  
1-18 the persons who would serve as members of the board, determine to  
1-19 create a board; and

1-20 (2) the commissioners court approves the creation of  
1-21 the board by a majority vote.

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-26 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
