5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 26, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 26.048 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 26.048. TERM LIMITS IN POPULOUS MUNICIPALITIES.
8	(a) This section applies only to a municipality with a population
9	of 1.8 million or more.
10	(b) In this section:
11	(1) "Governing body of a municipality" includes the
12	mayor of the municipality.
13	(2) "Municipal term limit" means a provision in a
14	municipal charter or ordinance that imposes a limit on the number of
15	terms or otherwise restricts the length of service a member of the
16	governing body of a municipality may serve on the governing body.

- 16 17 (c) The governing body of the municipality shall decide
- whether an election held under this section will authorize term 18
- 19 limits for members of the governing body of the municipality
- consisting of a maximum of: 20
- 21 (1) three four-year terms; or
- 22 (2) six two-year terms.
- 23 (d) The mayor of a municipality shall order an election in
- 24 the municipality on the first November uniform election date that

- 1 occurs in an even-numbered year after this section becomes
- 2 applicable to the municipality on the question of imposing term
- 3 limits on the members of the governing body of the municipality.
- 4 (e) The ballot at the election must be printed to permit
- 5 voting for or against the proposition: "Authorizing term limits
- 6 consisting of (insert number of terms and length of terms) on a
- 7 person's service on the governing body of the City of (insert name
- 8 of municipality)."
- 9 (f) If a majority of the votes received at the election
- 10 favor the proposition, the number and length of terms a person may
- 11 serve on the governing body is limited as provided in the
- 12 proposition. The municipality shall adjust the length of the terms
- 13 of the members of the governing body as necessary to comply with the
- 14 proposition.
- 15 (g) If less than a majority of the votes received at the
- 16 election favor the proposition, municipal term limits and the
- 17 length of the terms of the members of the governing body that
- 18 existed before the election are not affected.
- 19 (h) In applying a term limit authorized by this section:
- 20 (1) a term to which a member of the governing body was
- 21 elected or appointed before the election held under Subsection (d)
- 22 <u>is counted only if the member served one-half or more of the term;</u>
- 23 and
- 24 (2) a partial term to which a member of the governing
- 25 body is elected or appointed on or after the date of the election
- 26 held under Subsection (d) is counted only if the member serves
- 27 <u>one-half or more of the term.</u>
