- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 437, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Section 437.0057 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 437.0057. REGULATION OF FOOD HANDLERS BY COUNTIES,
- 7 PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICTS, AND THE DEPARTMENT. (a) A county, a
- 8 public health district, or the department may require certification
- 9 under Subchapter D, Chapter 438, for each food handler who is
- 10 employed by a food service establishment in which food is prepared
- 11 on-site for sale to the public and which holds a permit issued by
- 12 the county, the public health district, or the department. This
- 13 <u>section applies without regard to whether the food service</u>
- 14 establishment is at a fixed location or is a mobile food unit.
- 15 (b) A county, a public health district, or the department
- 16 may not require an establishment that handles only prepackaged food
- 17 and does not prepare or package food to employ certified food
- 18 handlers under this section.
- 19 (c) The department by rule may exempt a category of food
- 20 service estab<u>lishment from the requirement that a county</u>, a public
- 21 health district, or the department may impose under Subsection (a)
- 22 <u>if the department determines that the application of Subsection (a)</u>
- 23 to that type of establishment is not necessary to protect public
- 24 health and safety.

- 1 (d) A county, a public health district, or the department
- 2 may exempt a category of food service establishment from the
- 3 requirement that the county, public health district, or department
- 4 has imposed under Subsection (a) if the county, the public health
- 5 district, or the department determines that the application of

- 7 protect public health and safety.
- 8 <u>(e) The following entities are exempt from a requirement</u>
- 9 imposed under Subsection (a):
- 10 (1) a bed and breakfast establishment described by
- 11 <u>Section 437.019(a) or (b); and</u>
- 12 (2) a child-care facility, as defined by Section
- 13 42.002, Human Resources Code.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
