A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to food handlers and other food service employees.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 437, Health and Safety Code, is amended
5	by adding Section 437.0057 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 437.0057. REGULATION OF FOOD HANDLERS AND OTHER FOOD
7	SERVICE EMPLOYEES BY COUNTIES, PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICTS, AND THE
8	DEPARTMENT. (a) A county, a public health district, or the
9	department may require certification under Subchapter D, Chapter
10	438, for each food handler who is employed by a food service
11	establishment in which food is prepared on-site for sale to the
12	public and which holds a permit issued by the county, the public
13	health district, or the department. This section applies without
14	regard to whether the food service establishment is at a fixed
15	location or is a mobile food unit.
16	(b) The requirements of certification under this section

18 Chapter 438. (c) A county, a public health district, or the department

may not be more stringent than the requirements of Subchapter D,

- may not require an establishment that handles only prepackaged food 20
- 21 and does not prepare or package food to employ certified food
- 22 handlers under this section.
- 23 (d) A county, a public health district, or the department
- may exempt a food service establishment from the requirement that 24

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- 1 the county, public health district, or department has imposed under
- 2 <u>Subsection (a) if the county, the public health district</u>, or the
- 3 department determines that the application of Subsection (a) to
- 4 that establishment is not necessary to protect public health and
- 5 safety.
- 6 (e) A county, a public health district, or the department
- 7 may require a food service establishment to:
- 8 (1) post a sign in a place conspicuous to employees, in
- 9 a form adopted by the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 10 Services Commission, describing a food service employee's
- 11 responsibilities to report certain health conditions to the permit
- 12 holder under rules adopted by the executive commissioner; or
- 13 (2) require that each food service employee sign a
- 14 written agreement in a form adopted by the executive commissioner
- 15 to report those health conditions.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 438.034, Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 438.034. EMPLOYEE CLEANLINESS. (a) A person
- 19 handling food or unsealed food containers shall:
- 20 (1) maintain personal cleanliness;
- 21 (2) wear clean outer garments;
- 22 (3) keep the person's hands clean; and
- 23 (4) [either:
- [(A)] wash the person's hands and exposed
- 25 portions of the person's arms with soap and water:
- 26 (A) before starting work;
- (B) $[\tau]$ during work as often as necessary to

- 1 avoid cross-contaminating food; and
- 2 (C) to maintain cleanliness, after smoking,
- 3 eating, and each visit to the toilet[; or
- 4 [(B) avoid bare-hand contact with exposed food by
- 5 the use of gloves or utensils and wash hands after smoking, eating,
- 6 and each visit to the toilet].
- 7 (b) A person handling food or unsealed food containers may
- 8 not contact with bare hands exposed ready-to-eat food unless:
- 9 (1) documentation is maintained at the food service
- 10 establishment listing the foods and food handling activities that
- 11 <u>involve bare-hand contact; and</u>
- 12 (2) the food service establishment uses two or more of
- 13 the following contamination control measures:
- 14 (A) requiring employees to perform double hand
- 15 washing;
- 16 (B) requiring employees to use fingernail
- 17 brushes while hand washing;
- 18 (C) requiring employees to use a hand sanitizer
- 19 after hand washing;
- 20 (D) implementing an incentive program that
- 21 encourages employees not to come to work when ill; and
- (E) any other contamination control measure
- 23 approved by the regulatory authority.
- SECTION 3. (a) Not later than December 1, 2009, the
- 25 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
- 26 shall adopt the form of the sign and the form of the employee
- 27 agreement under Section 437.0057(e), Health and Safety Code, as

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- 1 added by this Act.
- 2 (b) A county, a public health district, or the Department of
- 3 State Health Services may not require a food service establishment
- 4 to post the sign or have the food service employees sign an
- 5 agreement under Section 437.0057(e), Health and Safety Code, as
- 6 added by this Act, before January 1, 2010.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
