3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2171.004, Insurance Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 2171.004. [RATE] FILINGS. An insurer shall file with
7	the commissioner in accordance with Chapter 2251 the following
8	information for commercial group property insurance written under
9	this chapter in this state:
10	(1) rates;
11	(2) <u>deductibles;</u>
12	(3) supplementary rating information; and
13	(4) [(3)] pertinent supporting information.
14	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 2211, Insurance Code, is
15	amended by adding Section 2211.158 to read as follows:
16	Sec. 2211.158. RULES REGARDING COVERAGE. The commissioner
17	shall adopt rules as necessary to implement this subchapter,
18	including any rules necessary to:
19	(1) implement changes in the plan of operation; and
20	(2) standardize deductibles charged by the
21	association.
22	SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 2251, Insurance Code, is
23	amended by adding Section 2251.053 to read as follows:
24	Sec. 2251.053. DEDUCTIBLES. The commissioner by rule may

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- 1 establish standards by which an insurer shall set deductible
- 2 <u>amounts for residential and commercial insurance.</u>
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act applies only to an insurance policy or
- 4 contract or evidence of coverage that is delivered, issued for
- 5 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2010. An insurance
- 6 policy or contract or evidence of coverage delivered, issued for
- 7 delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2010, is governed by the law
- 8 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 9 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
