| 11 | (2) "Stun gun" means a device designed to propel darts            |
| 12 | or other projectiles attached to wires that, on contact, will     |
| 13 | deliver an electrical pulse capable of incapacitating a person.   |
| 14 | (b) A peace officer may not use a stun gun against an             |
| 15 | individual.   |
| 16 | (c) A law enforcement agency may not purchase a stun gun.         |
| 17 | (d) This article expires January 1, 2011.                         |
| 18 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.                 |
