Subchapter F, Chapter 1302, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Section 1302.2601 to read as follows: 15 16 Sec. 1302.2601. RENEWAL OF LICENSE OR REGISTRATION. (a) On payment of the required fee, a license or registration under this 17 chapter may be renewed annually. 18 (b) Notwithstanding Sections 51.401(c) and (d), a person 19 whose license or registration has been expired for more than 90 days 20 21 but less than two years may renew the license or registration by paying to the department a renewal fee that is equal to two times 22 23 the normally required renewal fee. A person whose license or registration has been expired for two years or more may not renew 24

1 <u>the license or registration</u>. The person may obtain a new license by 2 <u>complying with the requirements and procedures for obtaining an</u> 3 original license or registration.

4 SECTION 4. Not later than January 1, 2010, the Texas 5 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules under 6 Section 1302.101(f), Occupations Code, as added by this Act.

7 SECTION 5. (a) The change in law made by this Act by the 8 amendment of Section 1302.260, Occupations Code, applies only to a 9 license issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this 10 Act. A license issued or renewed before the effective date of this 11 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the license was 12 issued or renewed, and the former law is continued in effect for 13 that purpose.

(b) The change in law made by this Act by the enactment of Section 1302.2601(b), Occupations Code, applies only to a license or registration that expires on or after the effective date of this Act. A license or registration that expires before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the license or registration expired, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
