- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 7, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 7.037 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 7.037. REPORTING SCHEDULE. (a) To the extent
- 8 possible, the Texas Education Agency shall develop and maintain a
- 9 comprehensive schedule that addresses each reporting requirement
- 10 generally applicable to a school district, including requirements
- 11 imposed by a state agency or entity other than the Texas Education
- 12 Agency, and that specifies the date by which a school district must
- 13 comply with each requirement.
- 14 (b) A state agency that requires a school district to
- 15 periodically report information to that agency shall provide the
- 16 Texas Education Agency with information regarding the reporting
- 17 requirement as necessary to enable the Texas Education Agency to
- 18 <u>develop and maintain the schedule required by Subsection (a).</u>
- 19 <u>(c) The Texas Education Agency shall determine the</u>
- 20 appropriate format of the schedule required by Subsection (a) and
- 21 the manner in which the schedule is made readily accessible to
- 22 school districts.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
