## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

Τ	AN ACT
2	relating to the registration of certain vehicles used to provide
3	emergency incident rehabilitation services.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 502.2036 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 502.2036. VEHICLES USED FOR EMERGENCY INCIDENT
8	REHABILITATION. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Emergency incident rehabilitation" means the
10	providing of emergency incident support services for emergency
11	personnel, including firefighters, law enforcement personnel, and
12	emergency medical technicians.
13	(2) "Emergency incident support services" include:
14	(A) providing food, hydration, and shelter to
15	<pre>emergency personnel;</pre>
16	(B) monitoring emergency personnel; and
17	(C) performing duties at the request of the
18	person in charge of an emergency incident.
19	(b) The owner of a motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer
20	may apply for registration under Section 502.201 and is exempt from
21	the payment of the registration fee that would otherwise be
22	required by this chapter if the vehicle is owned and used
23	exclusively for emergency incident rehabilitation by a nonprofit
24	organization.

- 1 (c) An application for registration under this section must
- 2 include:
- 3 (1) a statement by the owner of the vehicle that the
- 4 vehicle is used exclusively for emergency incident rehabilitation
- 5 and has not been used for any other purpose;
- 6 (2) a statement signed by an officer of the nonprofit
- 7 organization that the vehicle has not been used for any purpose
- 8 other than emergency incident rehabilitation and qualifies for
- 9 registration under this section; and
- 10 (3) a reasonable description of the vehicle and the
- 11 equipment included in the vehicle.
- 12 (d) An applicant for registration under this section must
- 13 pay a fee of \$5.
- 14 (e) A motor vehicle registered under this section must
- 15 display the name of the organization that owns it on each front
- 16 do<u>or.</u>
- 17 <u>(f) A vehicle registered under this section must display at</u>
- 18 all times an appropriate license plate showing the vehicle's
- 19 status.
- 20 (g) A vehicle registered under this section that is used for
- 21 any purpose other than emergency incident rehabilitation by a
- 22 nonprofit organization that provides emergency incident
- 23 rehabilitation may not again be registered under this section by
- 24 that organization.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
