- SECTION 4. Section 254.0401, Election Code, as amended by
- 11 this Act, and Section 176.009, Local Government Code, as amended by

- 13 expenditures that is required to be filed under Chapter 254,
- 14 Election Code, on or after January 1, 2010.
- SECTION 5. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this
