4	SECTION 1. Section 85.009, Election Code, is repealed.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 85, Election Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 85.073 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 85.073. Election officers serving branch polling
8	place. (a) The early voting clerk shall designate for each branch
9	polling place a deputy early voting clerk as the election officer in
10	charge of the polling place.

- 11 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the composition of
 12 the set of election officers serving a branch polling place must
 13 provide representation for each political party conducting a
 14 primary election in the county.
- 15 <u>(c) For the general election for state and county officers</u>
 16 and for a special election to fill a vacancy in an office regularly
 17 filled at the general election for state and county officers, the
 18 composition of the set of election officers serving a branch
 19 polling place who are not employees of the county must, to the
 20 extent practicable, provide equal representation for each
 21 political party conducting a primary election in the county.
- SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
