1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 19.004(a), Election Code, is amended to
1-12 read as follows:

1-13 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), state funds
1-14 disbursed under this chapter may be used only to defray expenses of
1-15 the registrar's office in connection with voter registration,
1-16 including additional expenses related to:

1-17 (1) implementation of the National Voter Registration
1-18 Act of 1993 (42 U.S.C. Section 1973gg et seq.); ~~and~~

1-19 (2) complying with the weekly updating requirements
1-20 prescribed by Section 18.063; and

1-21 (3) the employment of temporary voter registration
1-22 personnel for not more than 39 weeks in a state fiscal year.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
