## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to streamlining voter re-registration across county
- 3 lines.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 15.052(a) and (b), Election Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The officially prescribed form for a confirmation
- 8 notice must include:
- 9 (1) a statement that, if the voter fails to submit to
- 10 the registrar a written, signed response confirming the voter's
- 11 current residence on or before the 30th day after the date the
- 12 confirmation notice is mailed:
- 13 (A) the voter is subject to submission of a
- 14 statement of residence before the voter may be accepted for voting
- in an election held after that deadline; or
- 16 (B) for a notice delivered under Section 14.023,
- 17 the voter will remain subject to submission of a statement of
- 18 residence before the voter may be accepted for voting in an
- 19 election; [and]
- 20 (2) a warning that the voter's registration is subject
- 21 to cancellation if the voter fails to confirm the voter's current
- 22 residence either by notifying the registrar in writing or voting on
- 23 a statement of residence before November 30 following the second
- 24 general election for state and county officers that occurs after

- 1 the date the confirmation notice is mailed; and
- 2 (3) a statement that the voter must include all of the
- 3 required information on the official confirmation notice response
- 4 form.
- 5 (b) The official confirmation notice response form must:
- 6 (1) provide spaces for the voter to include all of the
- 7 information that a person must include in an application to
- 8 register to vote under Section 13.002; and
- 9 (2) be postage prepaid and preaddressed for delivery
- 10 to the registrar.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 15.053(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 (a) Not later than the 30th day after the date a
- 14 confirmation notice is mailed, the voter shall submit to the
- 15 registrar a written, signed response to the notice that confirms
- 16 the voter's current residence. The response must contain all of the
- 17 information that a person must include in an application to
- 18 register to vote under Section 13.002.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 63.0011(c), Election Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (c) Before being accepted for voting, the voter must execute
- 22 and submit to an election officer a statement including:
- 23 (1) a statement that the voter satisfies the
- 24 applicable residence requirements prescribed by Subsection (b);
- 25 (2) all of the information that a person must include
- 26 in an application to register to vote under Section 13.002 [the
- 27 voter's residence address or, if the residence has no address, the

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- 1 address at which the voter receives mail and a concise description
- 2 of the location of the voter's residence]; and
- 3 (3) [the month, day, and year of the voter's birth; and
- 4  $\left[\frac{(4)}{}\right]$  the date the statement is submitted to the
- 5 election officer.
- 6 SECTION 4. Not later than September 1, 2009, the secretary
- 7 of state shall prescribe:
- 8 (1) official forms for a confirmation notice and
- 9 confirmation notice response that meet the requirements of Section
- 10 15.052, Election Code, as amended by this Act; and
- 11 (2) a form that may be used for the statement of
- 12 residence that meets the requirements of Section 63.0011(c),
- 13 Election Code, as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
