## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the amount of hazardous duty pay for certain employees
3	of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 659.305(h), Government Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(h) The amount of hazardous duty pay for a particular month
8	for a full-time <u>state employee</u> [correctional officer] employed by
9	the Texas Department of Criminal Justice is the lesser of:
10	(1) \$12 for each 12-month period of lifetime service
11	credit accrued by the employee; or
12	(2) \$300.
13	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
