## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the change in fuel mandates for the percent of megawatts
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 39.9044 and 39.9048, Utilities Code,
- 6 are repealed

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- 7 SECTION 2. Section 40.004, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 40.004. JURISDICTION OF COMMISSION. Except as
- 10 specifically otherwise provided in this chapter, the commission has
- 11 jurisdiction over municipally owned utilities only for the
- 12 following purposes:
- 13 (1) to regulate wholesale transmission rates and
- 14 service, including terms of access, to the extent provided by
- 15 Subchapter A, Chapter 35;
- 16 (2) to regulate certification of retail service areas
- 17 to the extent provided by Chapter 37;

of generating capacity installed.

- 18 (3) to regulate rates on appeal under Subchapters D
- 19 and E, Chapter 33, subject to Section 40.051(c);
- 20 (4) to establish a code of conduct as provided by
- 21 Section 39.157(e) applicable to anticompetitive activities and to
- 22 affiliate activities limited to structurally unbundled affiliates
- 23 of municipally owned utilities, subject to Section 40.054;
- 24 (5) to establish terms and conditions for open access

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- 1 to transmission and distribution facilities for municipally owned
- 2 utilities providing customer choice, as provided by Section 39.203;
- 3 (6) to require collection of the nonbypassable fee
- 4 established under Section 39.903(b) and to administer the renewable
- 5 energy credits program under Section 39.904(b) [and the natural gas
- 6 energy credits program under Section 39.9044(b)]; and
- 7 (7) to require reports of municipally owned utility
- 8 operations only to the extent necessary to:
- 9 (A) enable the commission to determine the
- 10 aggregate load and energy requirements of the state and the
- 11 resources available to serve that load; or
- 12 (B) enable the commission to determine
- 13 information relating to market power as provided by Section 39.155.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
